

The Barking Orange: New Rules Effective 6/15/2020

- Upon re-opening, we will be operating on a reduced hours schedule: 7am-5:30pm Mondays only. Tuesday-Friday we are open 7am-6:30pm.
- Masks or face coverings must be worn when in public per the mandate of the CDC guidelines and New York State. If you cannot maintain 6 feet of social distance, you must wear a mask. If you wear a mask at the grocery store, you must wear one here. We ask that you wear a mask when you drop off and pick up your dog.
- Our lobby will remain locked to the public. All dogs will go in and out using our outdoor crate system in the back outside area. Please call us if you need to speak with us or need assistance. We will be monitoring our outdoor area and parking lot and will see you! When dropping off your dog and picking them up, we are asking that you maintain 6 feet of distance between customers and wear a mask. In the event of bad weather, remain in your car and we will come to you.
- If you are sick or have someone sick in your immediate family, we ask that you not come to daycare.
- All payments must be made online or over the phone on the day of service. However we will definitely accept exact change or checks as this will help keep some of our overhead costs as we attempt to re-open and get back to "normal". Check and cash can be distributed using our mail slot on the left side of the building.
- NO personal items are allowed inside our facility. This includes collars, leashes, seresto / flea collars, food containers, etc. We ask that you leave all of that at home or with you in your car. We will use our slip leads handling the dogs. Please bring lunch/snacks in a plastic bag that will be disposed of after use. They will not be returned to you.
- Our staff will maintain 6 feet of social distance and wear masks when we cannot be more than 6 feet apart. Employees who are sick will stay home. If you feel you have been exposed to Coronavirus, please let us know. We will do the same.
- We will continue to maintain and sterilize our facility as we always have been, including routinely cleaning our outdoor crate. The safety and the wellness of our staff, clients and dogs remains our number one priority.
- We are subject to close at any time per the orders of the state and federal governments, or if we feel it is unsafe at any time. These rules and guidelines are also subject to change at anytime.
